General questions about English

Children from Nursery, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 have feedback on English. Some of the questions asked may have been slightly re-worded so they were accessible to children of all ages

What happens in the story of The Three Little Pigs?

- *The pigs make a house of bricks, sticks and straw.
- *The wolf blows the house of sticks and straw down.
- *The pigs live in the houses.
- *The wolf climbs on the roof on the house of bricks, goes down the chimney and shoots up into the sky.
- *The wolf burns his tail in a pot of fire.

Which is your favourite character and why?

- *The pigs because they are and good.
- *The wolf because he shoots up in the sky and I want to do that.

Can you tell me which words rhyme when I read this part?

*Children unsure of what rhyming words are and couldn't find the words that sound the same.

Can you join in parts of the story of The Three Little Pigs?

*Children able to join in with the part of the wolf where he huffs and puffs and blows the house down.

What is your favourite story and why?

- *Little Red Riding Hood because she is a nice person.
- *Billy Goat's Gruff because I like the troll that hides from everyone.

Action to take as a result of Pupil Feedback on English

*More work on listening to and finding rhyming words and thinking of their own.
