

Vocabulary

Hace calor – it is hot

Hace frio – It is cold

Hace fresco – It is cold

Hace buen tiempo – The weather is nice.

Hace sol – It is sunny

Hace viento – It is windy

Está nublado – It is cloudy

Está lloviendo – It is raining

Está tormentoso – It is stormy

Está nevando – It is snowing

Hay niebla – It is foggy

El invierno – Winter

La primavera – Spring

El verano – Summer

El otoño – Autumn

Va a hacer viento – It's going to be windy

Va a hacer sol – It's going to be sunny

Va a hacer calor – It's going to be hot

Va a llover – It's going to rain

¿Qué tiempo hace?

(What is the weather like?)



Main questions and replies:

¿Qué tiempo hace? – What is the weather like?

Hoy está soleado – Today, it is sunny.

¿Cómo será el tiempo mañana? – What will the weather be like tomorrow?

Mañana va a llover y hacer viento – Tomorrow, it's going to rain and be windy.

¿Qué tiempo hace el invierno? – What is the weather like in winter?

En invierno, hace muy frio y nieva – In winter, it's very cold and snowy.

Prior learning

Basic greetings, numbers 1 -200, days/months, pets, family members, nationalities, body parts, colours, following classroom instructions, describing school, giving directions, places in a town.

Remember:

When talking about the weather in Spanish, different weather types are preceded by different verbs. When describing the overall feel of the weather, use 'hace',

E.g. Hace frio – It is cold

For more specific and changeable weather conditions, use 'Está'

E.g. Está lloviendo – It is raining
