Prior learning

Basic greetings, numbers 1 -200,
days/months, pets, family members,
nationalities, body parts, colours,
following classroom instructions,
describing school, giving directions,
places in a town, weather and seasons.

Remember:

In Spanish, the ending of a profession
often changes depending on whether a
man or a woman is completing it.

Usually:

- If the profession ends in 'o', this
changes to 'a' for a female.

e.g 'bombero' is a male firefighter;

'bombero' is a female firefighter.

- If the profession ends in a consonant,
add an 'a' for the female equivalent.

e.g. 'profesor' is a male teacher.

'profesora' is a female teacher.

- If the profession ends is 'ista', this
doesn't change for male or female.

There are however exceptions to these
rules.
