Prior learning

Basic greetings, numbers 1 - 200, days of the week, months of the year, pets, family members, likes/dislikes of food and sports, describing yourself and others.

¿Tocas algún instrumentos musicales?

Do you play any musical instruments?



Main questions and replies:

¿Tocas algún instrumentos musicales? – Do you play any musical instruments?

Si. Toco el clarinete – Yes. I play the clarinet.

No. No toco algún instrumentos musicales – No I don't play any musical instruments

¿Que tipo de música te gusta? – What type of music do you like?

Me gusta escuchar la música clásica y la música jazz pero no me gusta la música reggae. – I like to listen to classical music and jazz music, but I don't like reggae music.

Remember:

For musical instruments, we use the verb 'tocar' (to touch) rather than the verb 'jugar' (to play). This is conjugated depending on who is playing the instrument e.g.

Toco la flauta (I play the flute).

Tocas el clarinet (You play the clarinet)

Toca el teclado (He/she/it plays the keyboard)

Tocamos la guitarra (we play the guitar).

To talk about someone else, we can use their name before the verb.

Eg. **Jamie toca** la batería y la guitarra (Jamie plays the drums and the guitar)
