John Sentamu	Former Archbishop of York originally from Uganda.
Traidcraft	A UK based fair trade organisation.
Mother Teresa	Albanian Roman Catholic nun who served for many years in Calcutta India.
transformation	A process by which there is a marked change in someone's nature.
