Key Vocabulary	
Son of God	Christian belief that Jesus is part of the Trinity
sabbath/ shabbat	Jewish day of rest set aside as holy
authority	The power or right to be in control
pharisee	Member of a Jewish sect at the time of Jesus who believed in strict observance of the Jewish laws.
Mohammad	Founder of Islam revered by muslims as a prophet

Prior learning
