<u>Phone calls home</u> – Our staff have continued to make contact with children at home this term via weekly phone calls home. The aim of these informal calls has been to support you and your child with home learning and to see if there is anything else we can do to help you with while your children are at home. For our 'official' parents' evening, we will be continuing with a 'formal' 10 minute phone call home to replace our usual 'face to



face' meetings. An initial email will be sent to you asking you to contact the school/nursery office to arrange a date and time for your call. So that we can collate all the information, you will be asked to do this by a given date. <u>Year 5 Hinning House residential</u> – I have recently emailed all Year 5 parents/carers regarding our Hinning House residential. The review planned by the government education group to take place in February, will still be taking place. It is within this review that a decision will be made about outdoor centres and residential trips taking place after Easter 2021. Please note, any decision regarding the going ahead of our planned April trip will be made in light of the government review and also in conjunction with our school governors. We are

currently collating your responses to my email and we now await the outcome of the government review.

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Some of our staff in school have 'opted-in' to have a twice weekly COVID-19 test. These will start from next week onwards



<u>School Swimming</u> – Our children in Year 3 and Year 4 usually start school swimming lessons at The Pelican Centre after February half term each year. As things currently stand, our children will be returning to school on Monday 8th March and so we are planning that our school swimming sessions will go ahead from this point onwards. Therefore, I will email all Year 3 and Year 4 parents/carers after half term with our usual information

sheet regarding school swimming. Unless anything changes, we will continue to make plans for school for swimming to start upon our planned return on Monday 8th March.



<u>'Celebration days' in school</u> – Tuesday 9th February is Safer Internet Day and we will be celebrating Chinese New Year on Friday 12th February. On these days, activities will be set in school (and via Seesaw for children at home) to support your children's understanding of these important events.



<u>Reception starters 2021</u> – If you have a church card to support your child's application into our school for September 2021, please ensure you hand this in at the school office by <u>Monday 1st March 2021</u>.



Just so that you can start to make your half term arrangements, we currently have **no plans** for school to be open to any children during the February half term. I am aware that many of you have made use of informal 'childcare bubbles' during the recent national lockdown and so you can now start to put any arrangements in place for the half term week. Both our sites will close to children on Friday 12th February and re-open to key worker and other identified children on Monday 22nd February.
